Animal Services

- Animal Services Department is responsible for Animal Control and Animal Sheltering activities within Franklin County.
- Our Mission: To provide the citizens of Franklin County with the highest level of animal services by enforcement of our State and Local laws, to promote public safety, health, responsible pet ownership and animal welfare.

Animal Sheltering

FC Ordinance Section 3

All lost and stray animals at the shelter are kept for a minimum of 3 days.

Shelter Fees:

Adoption	\$25
Rescue	\$10
Redemption	\$25
Board	\$10 per day
Rabies Vx	\$5 each

**Fees are same for cats and dogs.*



Animal Bites

FC Ordinance Section 2-5

REPORT ALL ANIMAL BITES TO ANIMAL CONTROL ASAP

Dogs and Cats must be quarantined for 10 days in a veterinary hospital, boarding kennel, or County Animal Shelter

Current Rabies Vaccinations

FC Ordinance Section 2-2, 2-3, 2-4

It shall be unlawful for an owner to fail to provide current inoculations against rabies for any of the owner's dog(s) and cat(s) that are (4) months of age or older.

DOG: It shall be unlawful for any dog owner to fail to provide the dog with a collar or harness to which a current rabies tag issued is securely attached.

CATS: Cats are not required to wear rabies tags, but the cat owner must maintain the current Rabies Vaccination Certificate(s) as written evidence.

Animal Welfare

FC Ordinance Section 1-6

It shall be unlawful for the owner of an animal to fail or refuse to provide such animal with adequate food and water.

Animals Creating Nuisance

FC Ordinance Section 1-8

It shall be unlawful for any owner to keep, possess, or maintain an animal that:

- habitually causes damage to real or personal property such as gardens, dwellings or parts thereof
- repeatedly or persistently chases, snaps at, or otherwise molests pedestrians, bicyclists, motor-vehicle passengers, or domestic animals or pets.
- habitually or continually loiters about public places.
- is diseased and dangerous to the health of the public unless under the care of a veterinarian.

Female dogs in estrus must be confined in a secure enclosure or building.

Animals At-Large and Wandering Strays

FC Ordinance Section 1-7

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any animal to permit such animal to be wandering stray and be at-large.
